MINUTES OF MEETING

APRIL 18, 2022

The April meeting was held in person at borough hall and also via teleconference. The regular meeting of the Ramsey Recreation Commission was called to order by Recreation Director Popolo at 7:30 p.m. Present via teleconference were Mr. Kemp and Mrs. Oliver. Commissioners. Present at borough hall was Mr. Winterhalter, Commissioner. Mr. Blasius, Mrs. Fitzgerald, Mr. Jachts, Mr. Jarvis, Mr. Siraki, and Council Liaison Gutwetter were absent.

MINUTES

Mr. Winterhalter moved that the minutes of the March 21, 2022 meeting be approved as received, seconded by Mrs. Oliver, and passed.

ACTIVITY REPORTS (OLD/NEW BUSINESS)

Mrs. Dey noted that the by-laws should be in the possession of the governing body for approval.

The Spring Egg Hunt, scheduled for Saturday, April 2nd, went very well. The supply of plastic eggs has been depleted.

Ramsey's 50th Home Run Derby is scheduled for Saturday, June 18, 2022. Mrs. Dey has been in contact with Paul Bradley from the Phillies. Ramsey's six overall winners through the years will be recognized prior to the 2022 contest. Rather than have a cake, baseball and softball cookies with the number 50 on them will be available. An e-mail was sent to the RBSA, detailing the plans so far. The concession stand will be open. Hopefully, recreation clothing will be available in time for this event. The Bradley brothers will also be given Ramsey Recreation shirts. Mrs. Dey submitted an article about the derby to the *Ramsey Journal* which she also sent to *Ramsey Neighbors* after they contacted her.

CapturePoint went live for summer camp on Tuesday, April 12th, and there were 185 registrations that day. As of Monday, April 18th, registrations total 214. The numbers are capped at 400 total campers.

The lacrosse clinic is going well.

Women's over 23 softball and the adult softball league will begin on Sunday, April 24th. Men's over 45 softball started on Sunday, April 10th. Recreation will not be offering an adult soccer league in 2022.

The Opening Day parade for baseball and softball, scheduled for Saturday, April 9th, was rained out but league play has started, often impacted by bad weather.

The July meeting will be the summer meeting that will be cancelled.

The Ramsey Run will be going back to September, with a date to be finalized in May.
