

## WHAT ARE UNDERLYING HEALTH CONDITIONS?

- These are diseases or illnesses that may put a person more at risk for complications from COVID-19
- People of any age can have underlying health conditions
- People with COVID-19 and high blood pressure that was untreated or not managed were found to be **two times more at risk for death** compared to those with high blood pressure that was managed<sup>1</sup>
- People with underlying health conditions were found to be **six times more likely to be hospitalized** and **12 times more likely to die** compared to those who reported no underlying health conditions<sup>2,3</sup>

The most common underlying health conditions reported in the U.S. include:



**Heart disease**  
(includes high blood pressure)



**Diabetes**



**Lung disease**  
(includes asthma and emphysema)



**Obesity**
