

RAMSEY POOL COMMISSION
MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING, TUESDAY, MARCH 23, 2010

The monthly meeting of the Pool Commission was called to order at 7:47 p.m., Tuesday, March 23, 2010, by Chairman Heller. Also present were Mrs. Jordan, Commission member, Council Liaison Vozech, Mr. Collins, Pool Manager, and Mrs. Dey, Secretary.

In accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, public notice of the meeting was published in The Record and The Ridgewood News and posted in the Municipal Building.

Since there was no quorum, the February 23, 2010 minutes will be approved at the April meeting.

REPORT OF THE POOL DIRECTOR

The pool painting was awarded to A & A Painting and Contracting Co. of Highland Park. If they have any concerns regarding any mechanical aspect at the pool, they do have a subcontractor. Their references were checked out by Borough Attorney Scandariato and Mr. Mammone. Mr. Collins met with the pool painters on Saturday, March 13th at which time he showed them the pumps and the filtration system.

Mr. Collins contacted Mr. Horton, regarding the DPW cleanout of the pool in early April.

The recent March storms brought down three limbs at the pool which will be removed by the DPW.

All vendor quotes are due by the end of the month and will be awarded in April.

The first meeting of the NJPMA was held on Tuesday, March 9th. Mr. Collins met with Gill Associates of Totowa who will present information about a camera system at an upcoming meeting, possibly August or September.

An insurance meeting with borough officials is scheduled for April 1st.

Staff letter responses are due back at the beginning of April. One position in the refreshment stand will be eliminated. Dot Holmes, a senior citizen, will be moved to the front office. The kiddie pool may become a lifeguard station.

Swim team coach, Nicky DeCaro, will be returning for the 2010 season. One of the assistant coaches, Jason, may be able to help in June but he will be studying in England in July and August.

The Bergen Barracudas will be charged \$4000 for the 2010 season. Members of the Barracudas will be encouraged to join the Ramsey pool. They would be able to join the Ramsey swim team, a less competitive swimming experience.

Mr. Collins will request a postponement for the electrical wiring project in the filter room.

CFM will do the bonding and grounding work for the five-year certificate. CFM has also offered to be available if there are any pre-season issues.
