

# **RAMSEY RECREATION COMMISSION**

## **MINUTES OF MEETING**

**FEBRUARY 18, 2019**

The regular meeting of the Ramsey Recreation Commission was called to order by Mrs. Oliver at 7:40 p.m. Also present were Mr. Kemp, Mr. Siraki, Mr. Winterhalter, Commissioners, and Council Liaison Verdone. Mr. Blasius, Mrs. Fitzgerald, Mr. Mannion, Mr. Popolo, and Recreation Director Patterson were absent.

### **MINUTES**

Mrs. Oliver moved that the minutes of the January 21, 2019 meeting be approved as received, seconded by Mr. Siraki, and passed.

### **ACTIVITY REPORTS (OLD/NEW BUSINESS)**

Recreation registrations will be done via CapturePoint beginning in 2019. To cover salaries due to the minimum wage increase, the camp fees were raised to \$225 for one camper and \$350 for a family (Early Bird rates) and \$275 for one camper and \$400 for a family (regular rates).

Councilman Verdone requested receipt of the meeting minutes prior to the monthly work session of the governing body. He noted that the RIFE Valentine's Dance was an excellent event.

Mrs. Oliver provided the latest information about the wrestling program. On the high school level, Jonathan Siemsen was a district champ (126) as was his father, Andrew, when he was at Ramsey High School. Three high school wrestlers will be going to regionals. Nineteen Ramsey junior wrestlers participated in the tournament at Emerson; there were nine gold, four silver, and two bronze medalists. Eleven junior wrestlers will be going to regionals.

The senior citizens will be filling the Easter eggs once again. The location for the Easter egg hunt will be finalized. The donation request letter will be sent to Shop-Rite/Marie Sweeney-Tevis.

The list of upcoming recreation events will be forwarded to the women who are starting a new magazine in Ramsey.
