

RAMSEY POOL COMMISSION
MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING, WEDNESDAY, APRIL 17, 2019

The monthly meeting of the Pool Commission was called to order on Wednesday, April 17, 2019, at 8:00 p.m. by Vice-Chairman Hewitt. Also present were Mr. Haskell (arrived at 8:05 p.m.), Mrs. Hoffman, Mr. Jost, Mrs. Maurer, Mrs. Suarez, Commission members, Council Liaison Jones, Mr. Bach, Pool Manager, and Mrs. Dey, Secretary.

In accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, public notice of the meeting was published in The Record and The Ridgewood News and posted in the Municipal Building.

Mrs. Dey read the Open Public Meetings Law.

MINUTES

Upon motion by Mrs. Hewitt, seconded by Mrs. Hoffman, the minutes of the March 20, 2019 meeting were approved as received. Upon motion by Mr. Jost, seconded by Mrs. Hewitt, the minutes of the April 3, 2019 special meeting were approved as received.

Martin Vesey, 5 Park Place, asked about the location of the Gaga Ball Pit, noting that grass space will be at a premium. Mr. Bach observed that actually there will be more grass space than originally thought once the paths are removed. George Bumiller, 39 Lakeview Terrace, and Jennifer Sauer, 14 Blauvelt Avenue, were also present.

REPORT OF THE POOL MANAGER (AGENDA ITEMS)

The “early bird” rates will be extended to Wednesday, May 15th.

Contracts will be awarded to CFM for the pool start-up, to Uniscape for the grounds, and to D & S Land Development for the demolition of the pavilion.

Councilman Jones noted that there is a lot of misinformation regarding the construction at the pool. He has responded to numerous e-mails. The trusses will be coming in next week. If the work is not completed before Opening Day, there are contingencies for the bathrooms and the snack stand. The site will be safe and secure and the dirt mounds will be removed.
