Basketball and wrestling registrations will utilize CapturePoint. It is expected that registration will open on Friday, November 1<sup>st</sup>.

Councilman Verdone reported that there was Ramsey participation at the Senior Olympics. He will have the names of the winners for the November meeting. Next year there will be a push to publicize the event to generate better participation.

Mr. Popolo reported that Challenger Soccer started on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup>, and will run through mid-November. Performance Soccer Training is assisting with the weekly sessions when available. There will be a Halloween dance on Friday, October 25<sup>th</sup>, and a volleyball activity on Saturday, October 26<sup>th</sup>.

Home Run Derby began in 1971 and Ramsey was one of the participating communities that year. The Phillies will be doing something to celebrate fifty years of Home Run Derby and Ramsey will also be observing fifty years. Participation in this year's Home Run Derby was light. Publicizing the 2020 derby will be stepped up, beginning with the Fall Journal.
